ORDER GRANTING PETITION TO INTERVENE

On September 12, 2007, Stephen L. Bennett, John N. Nolte, and Carl & Deborah Larsen filed an appeal of water pollution control permit number NEV60025, issued on August 28, 2007, by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection for the North Valley Waste Water Treatment Facility in Douglas County, Nevada.

On September 19, 2007, Douglas County filed a Petition to intervene with the State Environmental Commission (SEC). As indicted in the Petition to Intervene, Douglas County has a direct and substantial interest in the appeal because it is the named permittee of the North Valley Waste Water Treatment Facility being appealed by the parties named above. Douglas County will therefore be directly affected by a decision of the SEC.
