- Proposed Amendments to NAC 445 of the Water Pollution Control Regulations to include an annual fee structure applicable to mining operations within the state to support additional staff resources for implementation of the permitting and compliance monitoring program.
- Proposed amendments to NAC 445 of the Water Pollution Control Regulations governing the State Revolving Loan Fund to finance the construction of wastewater treatment facilities.
- Proposed amendments to NAC 444.8632 to update the adoption of the applicable Code of Federal Regulations from July 1, 1988 to July 1, 1989.
