SMALL BUSINESS IMPACT DISCLOSURE PROCESS
PURSUANT TO 233B "Nevada Administrative Procedures Act"**

RE: Proposed Amendment to NAC 445B.3457 of Nevada's "AIR CONTROLS: AIR POLLUTION" Regulations

By: Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP), Bureaus of Air Pollution Control and Air Quality Planning

Note: Small Business is defined as a "business conducted for profit which employs fewer than 150 full-time or part-time employees" (NRS 233B.0382).

1. Does this proposed regulation impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a small business?

ANSWER: NO. The NDEP is proposing to amend one section in the permitting provisions of NAC 445B which deals with public notice requirements for Class II permit applications or modifications. The amendments do not lengthen the timeline for the Director's action on an application for a new permit or the modification of an existing permit, which might have impacted costs to the industry. Fees were not revised, and none of the other changes affect costs to industry.

2. Does this proposed regulation restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a small business?

ANSWER: NO. The amendments being proposed do not affect the formation, operation or expansion of the regulated industry.
