

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE  
STATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION**

AUTHORITY: NRS 444.560

**Section 1.** Chapter 444 of NAC is hereby amended by thereto the provisions set forth in sections 2 to x, inclusive.

**Sec. 2.** *The owner or operator of a facility for the management of solid waste, for which a permit or prior approval is required for its operation, closure or care after closure must, before the Administrator may issue a permit or approval to operate, pay a fee to the Division to offset the cost to process and review the application, as follows:*

| <i>Class I Landfill proposed to receive 500 tons per day or more.....</i>     | <i>..... \$65,000</i>  |
| <i>Class I Landfill proposed to receive less than 500 tons per day.....</i>   | <i>..... 5,000</i>     |
| <i>Class III Landfill proposed to receive 500 tons per day or more.....</i>   | <i>..... 50,000</i>    |
| <i>Class III Landfill proposed to receive less than 500 tons per day.....</i> | <i>..... 5,000</i>     |
| <i>Transfer station.....</i>  | <i>..... 1,000</i>     |
| <i>Waste Tire Management Facility.....</i>                                    | <i>..... 2,500</i>     |

**Sec. 3.** *The owner or operator of a solid waste disposal site for which a permit is required for its operation, closure or care after closure shall, on or before March 1 of each year, pay the following annual permit fee to the Division to offset partially the cost of inspection and other regulation of the facility:*

| <i>Permitted Disposal Site</i>  | <i>Annual Permit Fee</i> |
|---|--------------------------|
| <i>Class I Landfill receiving 500 tons per day or more based on an annual average.....</i>  | <i>\$65,000</i>          |
| <i>Class I Landfill receiving more than 100 tons per day but less than 500 tons per day, excluding sites with approved waivers of liner and ground water monitoring requirements.....</i> | <i>5,000</i>             |
| <i>Class III Landfill receiving 500 tons per day or more based on an annual average.....</i>  | <i>50,000</i>            |
| <i>Class III Landfill receiving more than 20 tons per day but less than 500 tons per day.....</i>   | <i>10,000</i>            |
| <i>Class III Landfill primarily receiving by-products from coal combustion.....</i>   | <i>20,000</i>            |

**Sec. 4.** *The owner or operator of a solid waste disposal site who wishes to modify the existing permit for the site shall pay to the Division the following fees before the modification may be granted:*

*(a) A fee of \$200 and;*

*(b) An additional fee of \$50 per hour for each hour beyond the first 4 hours of staff time devoted to reviewing and processing the proposed modification up to a maximum equivalent to the amount of the application fee for a new permit as specified in Section 2.*
