The NDEP is proposing to align the NAC with changes made to the NRS in the 2003 legislative session, and eliminate ambiguity in the demarcation of inspection and maintenance (I/M) program areas in Washoe and Clark Counties. The amendments will:

- Bring diesel vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating from 8,500 up to and including 10,000 pounds into the I/M program. (AB 36)
- Align the Clark County I/M program area in the NAC with what is in the Nevada I/M SIP.
- Clarify which areas are included in the I/M program in Washoe County and which are exempt.
